



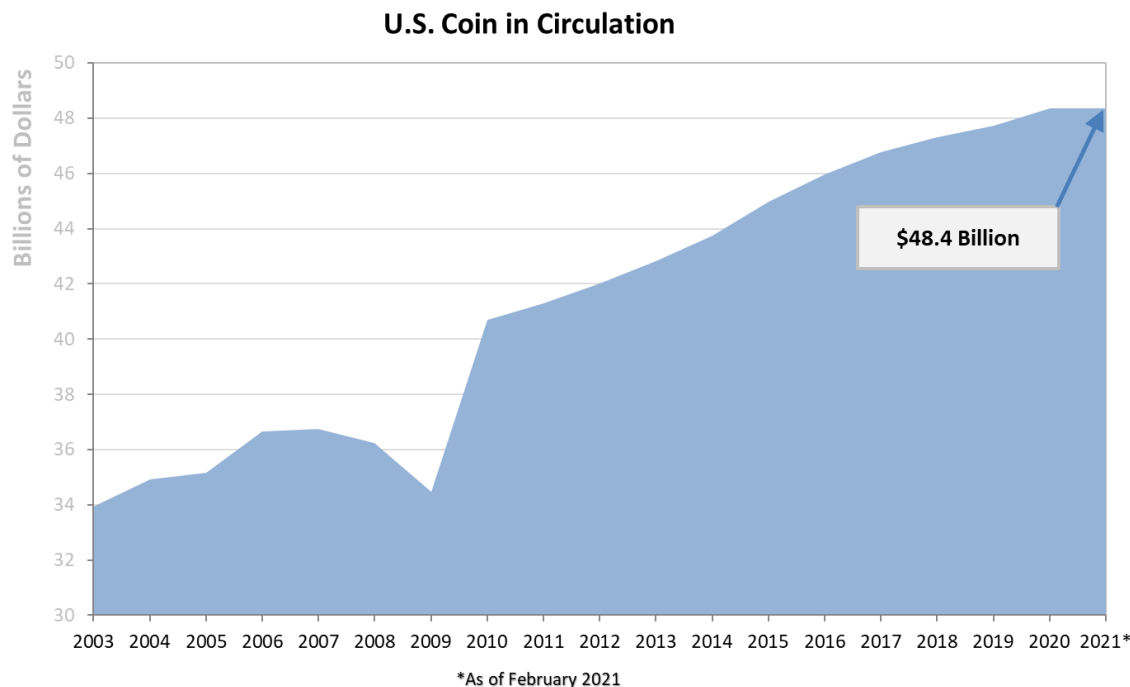

# U.S. Coin in Circulation is growing along with currency



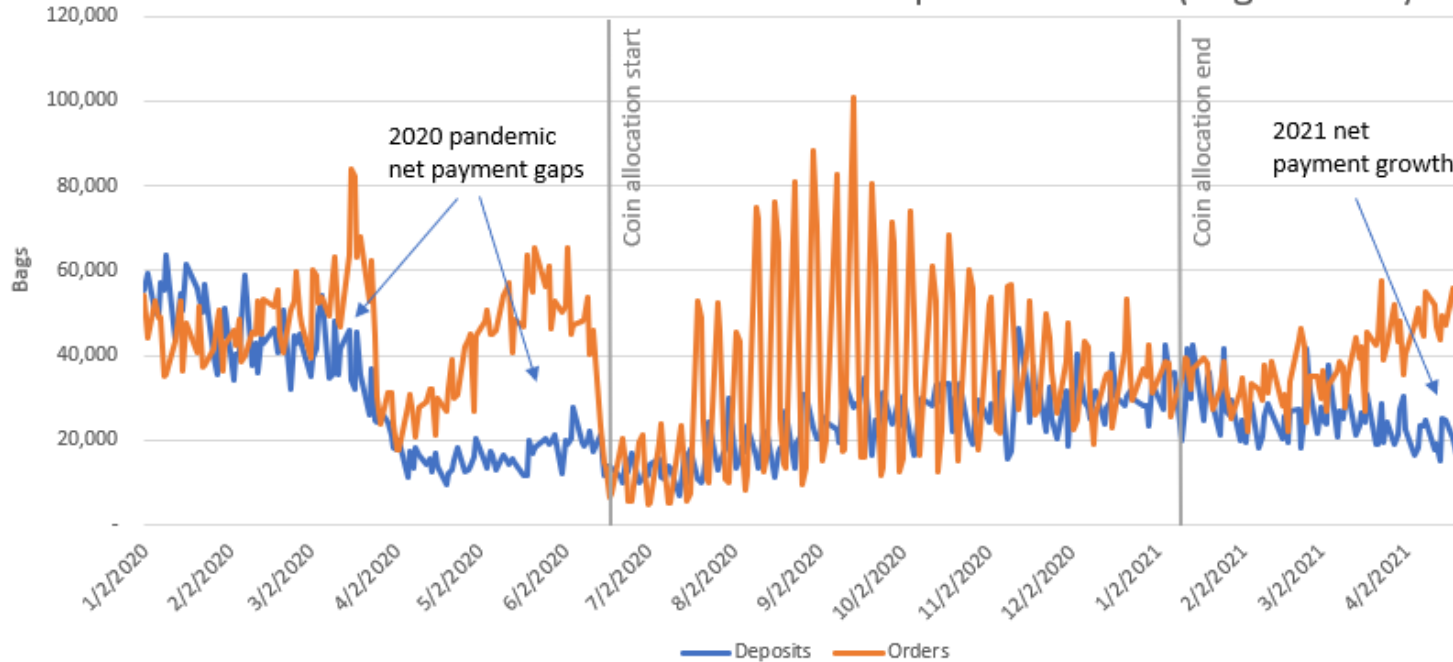
As of February 2021, U.S. coin in circulation reached **\$48.4 billion**

Coin in circulation is growing at a slower pace than currency

# COVID-19 impact on FRB coin volumes

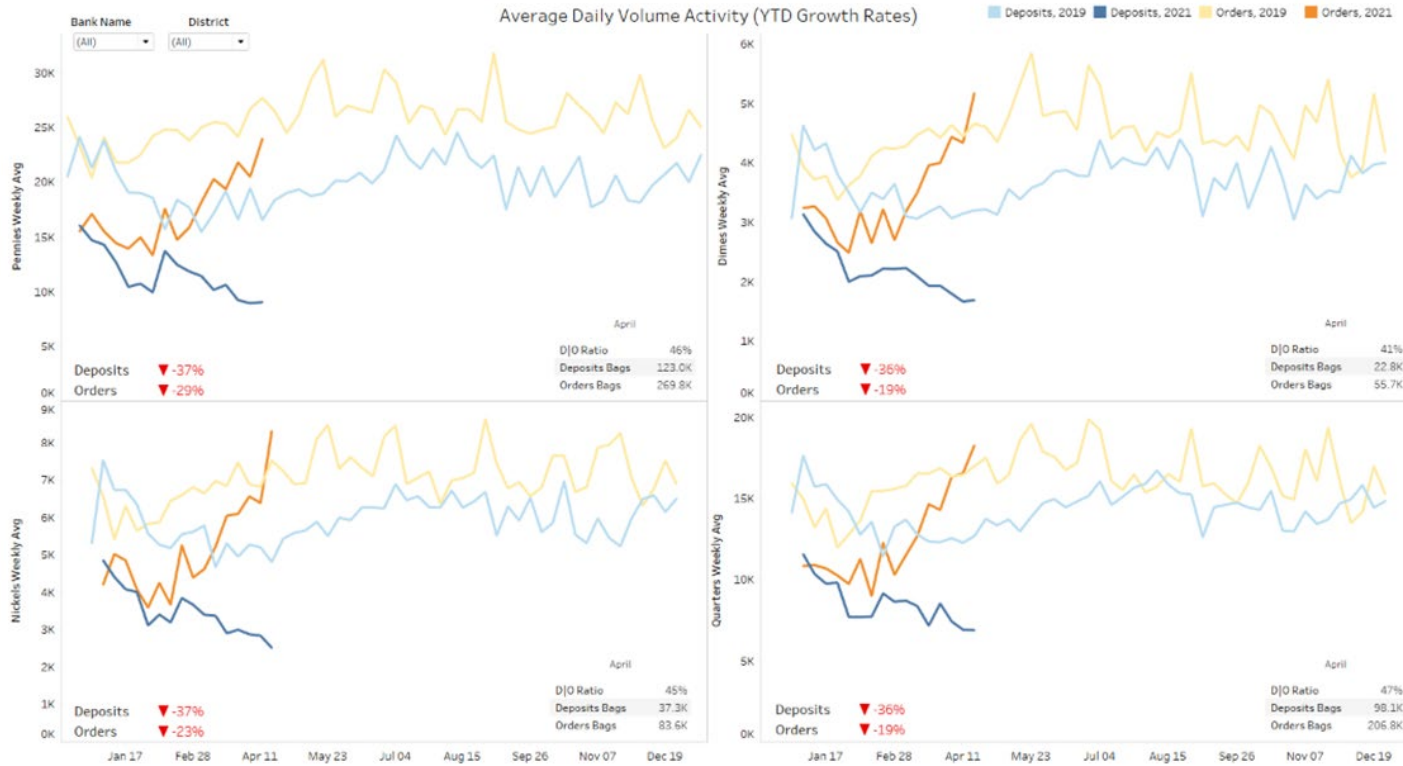


## 2020-2021 FRB Total Coin Order and Deposit Volumes (bags of coin)



Coin orders began increasing in March 2021, which is a normal seasonal pattern as financial institutions place orders to meet demand from spring break and associated holiday activity. However, this coin demand continues to grow beyond the typical seasonal period and coin deposits continue to decline. Additional insights are being sought from Cash supply chain partners.
